White City Canal Trail

The White City Canal Trail project utilized an abandoned canal to provide a significant north-south connection from 9400 South at Big Bear Park to the Sandy Canal Trail at 10600 South, which provides connectivity to other regional trails in the area including *Dimple Dell*, *Draper Canal*, *Jordan River Parkway* and *Porter Rockwell* and to the *Big Bear Park*. Additionally, the trail provides a safe route to local schools in the

surrounding neighborhoods.

The trail is a 12-foot wide paved multi-use, ADA accessible pedestrian/bike path and a 6-foot wide gravel trail along the existing canal corridor. The trails cross a 347-foot pedestrian bridge spanning over Dimple Dell Regional Park at approximately 800 East.

Funding for the trail was made possible by the Transportation Choice Fund and the 2016 ZAP 3 Parks & Recreation Bond.
